

Director of the Counseling Center – Notre Dame College

Notre Dame College seeks a Director of the Counseling Center to provide counseling services to students and leadership to an evolving Counseling Center. The successful candidate will be an experienced clinician who is passionate about the health and well-being of students, capable of assuming a leadership role in ongoing campus efforts to promote health and wellness, reduce high-risk behaviors among students, and strengthen campus crisis intervention and emergency response.

The Director is responsible for the leadership of the Counseling Center including providing individual and group therapy, crisis intervention, consultation, outreach programs and prevention strategies. In addition the Director will supervise counseling interns and be responsible for budgeting, planning, and policy development. The Director works collaboratively with other units within the Division of Student Affairs.

The successful candidate must possess a master's degree in psychology, counseling, or social work. Licensure in the State of Ohio (or license eligible) by the State Board of Psychology or Ohio Counselor, Social Worker, and Family Therapist Board (LPCC-S required). A doctorate in Counseling Psychology, Educational Psychology, or Clinical Psychology is preferred. Three years experience at a college counseling center or comparable professional setting is required.

Qualifications include experience in a college/university counseling center; demonstrated strong collaborative skills with Residence Life and other Student Affairs departments. Experience with a diverse college population of traditional, adult, and graduate students, and valuing inclusiveness in a campus community are required. Also required is the ability to communicate effectively, verbally and in writing. The Director must be able to support the mission of the College, its Catholic tradition, and its values. The position is full time, twelve month, and the salary is commensurate with education and experience.
